**RICCARDO MUTI AND CHICAGO SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA  
OPEN CARNEGIE HALL'S 2012/13 SEASON  
WITH THREE CONCERTS**

CHICAGO — The Chicago Symphony Orchestra and Music Director Riccardo Muti open Carnegie Hall's 2012/13 season with three performances on October 3, 4 and 5, 2012.

Muti and the CSO start Carnegie's season on Wednesday, October 3, 2012 with a gala performance of Orff's *Carmina Burana* featuring soprano Maria Grazia Schiavo and countertenor Antonio Giovannini, along with the Chicago Symphony Chorus and Chicago Children's Choir.

On Thursday, October 4, Muti and the CSO perform Wagner's Overture to *The Flying Dutchman* and Franck's Symphony in D Minor, along with the New York premiere of CSO Mead Composer-in-Residence Mason Bates' *Alternative Energy*, which receives its world premiere by Muti and the CSO at Symphony Center on Thursday, February 2, 2012.

Muti and the CSO close out their 2012 New York concerts on Friday, October 5 with a performance of Dvořák's Symphony No. 5, Martucci's *Notturmo* and Respighi's *Feste romane*.
